

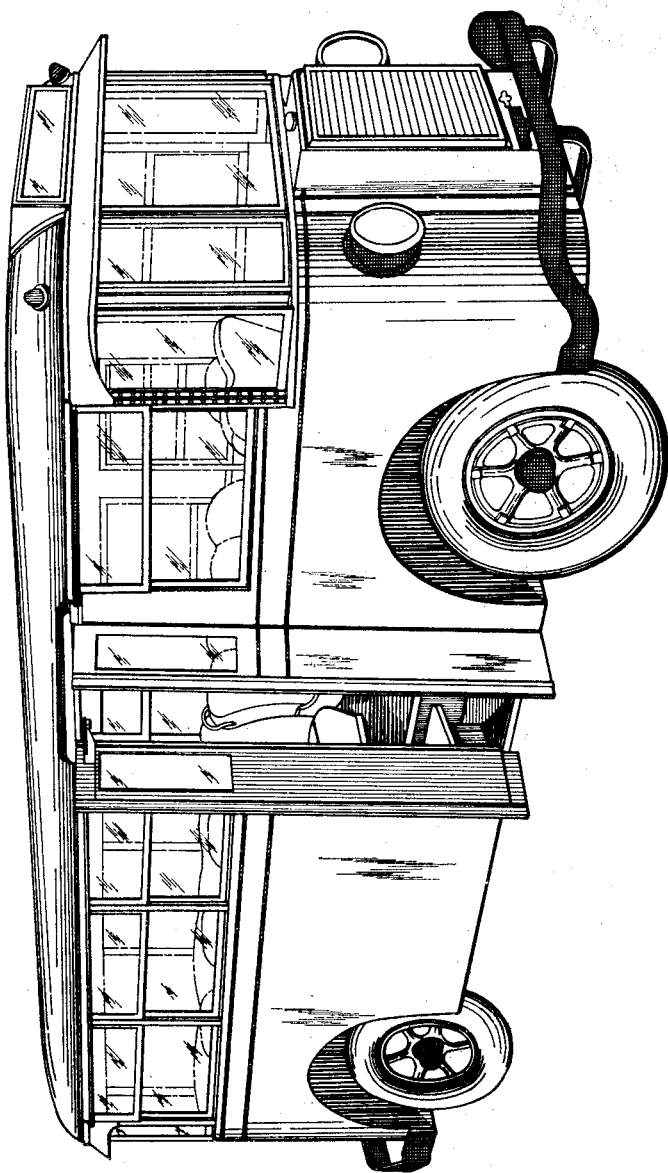

### DESIGN FOR A MOTOR VEHICLE

Application filed November 3, 1931. Serial No. 41,605. Term of patent 14 years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, WILLIAM B. FAGEOL, a citizen of the United States, residing at Kent, in the county of Portage and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Motor Vehicle, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

The figure is a perspective view of the vehicle showing my new design.

The side of the vehicle opposite to that from which the view was taken is substantially the same as that shown with the exception that no door opening is generally provided in said side.

I claim:

The ornamental design of a motor vehicle substantially as shown and described.
