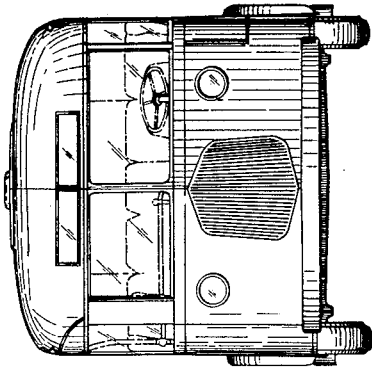

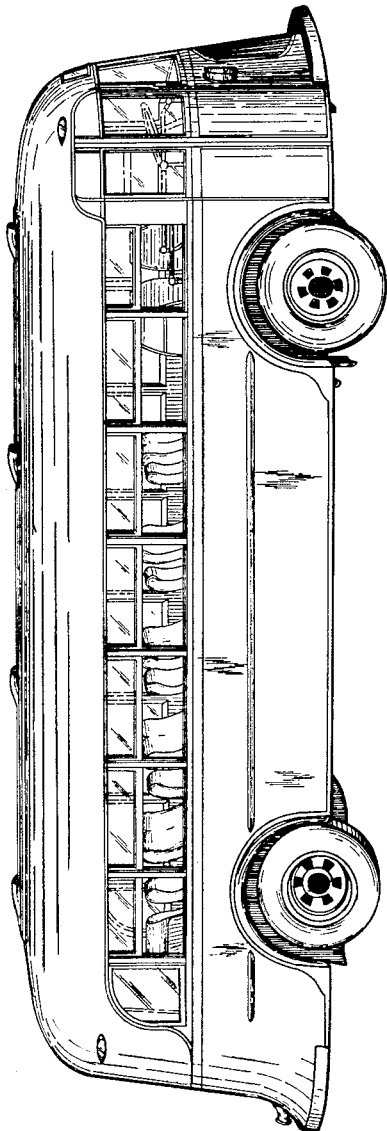

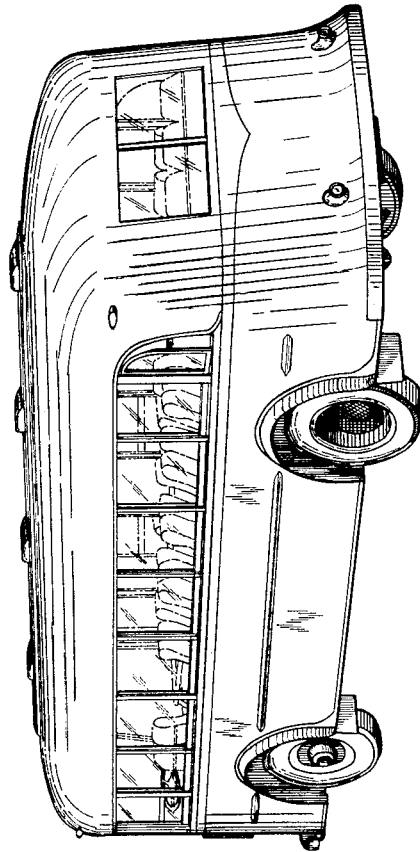

DESIGN FOR A MOTOR VEHICLE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WILLIAM B. FAGEOL, a citizen of the United States, residing at Kent, in the county of Portage and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Motor Vehicle, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof wherein.

Figure 1 is a side elevational view of the vehicle showing my new design.

Figure 2 is a view taken from the right of

Figure 1 showing the appearance of the vehicle embodying my novel design when viewed fully from the front.

Figure 3 is a perspective view of the vehicle as seen from the rear and discloses the side of the vehicle opposite from that shown in Figure 1.
